REPORT FOR THE PARISH COUNCIL

In January 1989 two Partney Charities known as The Poor's Gardens and Donor Unknown were amalgamated by the Charity Commission.

These two charities and the property thereof are now administered and managed together as The Partney Relief In Need Charity.

The Parish Field (from which rent is received annually)
Two Charity Fund Investment Accounts (one of which is a Permanent Endowment)
Quarterly dividends are received and all income is paid into the current account.

The application of the income is governed by guidelines set out by the Charity Commission namely to `Relieve either generally or individually persons resident in the Parish of Partney who are in conditions of need, hardship or distress'.

In order to satisfy this requirement, we have in recent years, been using the income to make an annual donation to Lincs and Notts Air Ambulance.

The Parish Field is immediately adjacent and to the east of the Cemetery.

This asset is currently being maintained as a grass field and as a 'blank canvas' so to speak.

There are currently 4 Trustees who act together, collectively reviewing the financial situation, reviewing the field, and making any decisions necessary.
