4. TO ADDRESS ANY ACTIONS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES:

<u>Clearing of the Beck.</u> The Parish Council have written to residents affected to make them aware of their responsibilities regarding clearing the Beck to ensure the water is free flowing. The Parish Clerk will write a further letter outlining the rights and responsibilities of Riperian owners. This will also include a reference to where residents can go for further information. It was suggested that if a homeowner cannot clear this themselves to hold a community clear up day. This is an ongoing problem and needs to be monitored.

Speeding and signs at Dalby. The Parish Clerk will contact Highways to review this issue. **Footpaths at Monks Lane.** The Parish Clerk has contacted the Council and has received no response. A follow up email will be sent.

<u>Gates at Dalby to Church.</u> The Parish Clerk has contacted the Council and has received no response. A follow up email will be sent. Cllr W. Grover suggested emailing Lincoln County Council direct. Another email will be sent by the Parish Clerk and will copy in Cllr Grover and Cllr Colin Davie.
